





PRAYER TO SAINT MAROUN

O glorious St. Maroun, father of the Maronite people, we the followers of Christ, who take our name also from you, glory in your patronage. We ask you who sought communion with God alone to intercede with the Lord our God for us.




PRAYER TO SAINT RAFQA

O Heavenly Father, You are glorified in Your saints. You bestowed grace upon Saint Nehmetallah, so he abandoned the world to live for You and with You in the solitude of the monastery.

O Lord Jesus, you called Saint Nehmetallah and filled him with Your grace and blessing, so he could follow You on the narrow path of perfection and holiness. He followed Your path carrying his cross with joy, the cross of communal life, by which he was sanctified.

O Holy Spirit, You have inspired Saint Nehmetallah, so that he became a monk and lived with his brethren in the monastery, where he educated them and managed all things wisely and prudently. He was an ideal teacher and encourager to Saint Charbel, his disciple, and many others.

We beseech you, O Holy Trinity, through Saint Nehmetallah, to enlighten the path of salvation before us, for You are the first and last aim. Bring us back to You and renew in us Your image and likeness.

A plenary indulgence is granted, if the Rosary is recited in a church or public oratory or in a family group, a religious community or pious association; a partial indulgence is granted in other circumstances. To gain a plenary indulgence, one must also go to Confession, receive Holy Communion and recite a prayer for the intentions of the Pope, e.g. one Our Father and one Hail Mary.

Intention

O my God, we believe, we adore, we hope and we love You! We ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love You.

Dearest Mother Mary, we offer up this Rosary with all the Rosaries throughout the world, for all your plans and intentions. We consecrate our homes, our families, our loved ones and all our Priests to your Immaculate Heart and the Sacred Heart of Jesus, our Lord and Saviour, burning with love for us in the Blessed Eucharist.

Dear Jesus, we offer this for love of You, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Most Holy Trinity, we adore You profoundly. We offer You the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges and indifference by which He Himself is offended.

Through the merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, we pray for the conversion of poor sinners throughout the world, for peace in our hearts, our homes, our families and our loved ones. We pray for all the holy souls in Purgatory, especially those who have no one to pray for them, and for all those who have asked our prayers. We also pray for the intentions within our own hearts. Amen.

(Pause now to consider intentions)

The Confiteor

I confess to Almighty God, and to you, my dear brothers and sisters, that I have sinned through my own fault, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and what I have failed to do; and I ask Blessed Mary, ever Virgin, all the holy Angels and Saints, and you here present, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

Our Father

Our Father, who art in Heaven; hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

The First Joyful Mystery THE ANNUNCIATION Spiritual Fruit: Humility

The Virgin Mary is greeted by the Angel Gabriel, who announces that she is to conceive by the power of the Holy Spirit, and her Son will be called the Son of God.

(Luke 1: 26 - 32)



The Second Joyful Mystery THE VISITATION Spiritual Fruit: Love of Neighbour

When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the Infant leapt in her womb, and filled with the Holy Spirit, she cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb!" (Luke 1: 39 - 56)



The Third Joyful Mystery THE BIRTH OF JESUS Spiritual Fruit: Poverty of Spirit

She gave birth to her firstborn Son, wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. (Luke 2: 7)



The Fourth Joyful Mystery THE PRESENTATION

Spiritual Fruit: Purity of Mind and Body

And when the days of her purification were fulfilled according to the Law of Moses, they took Him up to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord. (Luke 2: 22 - 23)



The Fifth Joyful Mystery THE FINDING OF THE CHILD JESUS IN THE TEMPLE

Spiritual Fruit: Obedience

The Child Jesus is lost for three days before the Blessed Virgin finds Him in the Temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions. (Luke 2: 46)

(Matthew 3: 13 - 17)



The Second Luminous Mystery THE MIRACLE AT THE WEDDING OF CANA

Spiritual Fruit: Fidelity

Jesus changes water into wine, the first of His signs, and reveals His glory; and His disciples believe in Him. (John 2: 11)



The Third Luminous Mystery THE PROCLAMATION OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Spiritual Fruit: Desire for Holiness

Jesus comes to Galilee proclaiming the Gospel, saying, "The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the good news."

(Mark 1:14 - 15)



The Fourth Luminous Mystery THE TRANSFIGURATION

Spiritual Fruit: Spiritual Courage

His face shone like the sun and His clothes became dazzling white. And behold, there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with Him. Then a bright cloud overshadowed them and a voice came from the cloud, saying, "This is My Son, the Chosen One; listen to Him."

(Matthew 17: 1 - 3)



Spiritual Fruit: Love of Our Eucharistic Lord

Jesus took a piece of bread, blessed and broke it, and giving it to His Apostles, said, "Take and eat; this is My Body." Then He took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them saying, "Drink from it, all of you, for this is My Blood of the New Covenant, which will be poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this in memory of Me."

(Matthew 26: 26 - 28)

(Luke 22: 44 - 45)



The Second Sorrowful Mystery THE SCOURGING AT THE PILLAR

Spiritual Fruit: Mortification of the Senses

Pilate then took Jesus and had Him scourged. (John 19: 1)



The Third Sorrowful Mystery THE CROWNING WITH THORNS

Spiritual Fruit: Reign of Christ in our Hearts

They stripped Him and put on Him a scarlet cloak; and plaiting a crown of thorns they put it on His head and a reed into His right hand. And kneeling before Him, they mocked Him, saying, "Hail, King of the Jews."

(Matthew 27: 28 - 31)



The Fourth Sorrowful Mystery THE CARRYING OF THE CROSS Spiritual Fruit: Patient Rearing

Spiritual Fruit: Patient Bearing of Trials

And bearing the cross for Himself, He went forth to the Place of the Skull, in Hebrew, Golgotha.

(John 19: 17)



The Fifth Sorrowful Mystery THE CRUCIFIXION

Spiritual Fruit: Pardoning of Injuries

Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies for our sins after three hours of agony. Crying out with a loud voice, He said, "Father into Thy Hands I commend my spirit." And having said this, He breathed His last.

(Luke 23: 33 - 46)

(Matthew 28:1-10)



The Second Glorious Mystery THE ASCENSION Spiritual Fruit: Christian Hope

Forty days after His resurrection Jesus ascends into Heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. (Mark 16: 19 - 20)



The Third Glorious Mystery **THE DESCENT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**Spiritual Fruit: Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Ten days after the Ascension, the Holy Spirit descends upon Mary and the Apostles in the form of fiery tongues. (Acts 2: 2 - 4)



The Fourth Glorious Mystery THE ASSUMPTION Spiritual Fruit: To go to Jesus through Mary

The Blessed Virgin finishes her life on earth and is assumed body and soul into the glory of Heaven amidst the rejoicing of the Angels.

(Revelation 12: 1 - 6)



The Fifth Glorious Mystery THE CORONATION Spiritual Fruit: Grace of Final Perseverance

The Daughter of God, the Mother of God and the Spouse of God is now crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth, Angels and men. Mary is truly "Queen of All Hearts." Trust in the intercession of Mother Mary for eternal happiness. (Revelation 21: 1 - 8)




HAIL HOLY QUEEN

Lord, I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.



It was the Curé of Ars who said, "A spiritual communion acts on the soul as blowing does on a cinder-covered fire which was about to go out. Whenever you feel your love of God growing cold, quickly make a spiritual communion."

PRAYER TO THE SHOULDER WOUND OF CHRIST

It is related in the annals of Clairvaux that St. Bernard asked Our Lord which was His greatest unrecorded suffering and Our Lord answered: "I had on My Shoulder, while I bore My Cross on the Way of Sorrows, a grievous Wound, which was more painful than the others and which is not recorded by men. Honour this Wound with your devotion and I will grant you whatsoever you ask through its virtue and merit. And in regard to all those who shall venerate this Wound, I will remit to them all their venial sins and will no longer remember their mortal sins."

O Loving Jesus, meek Lamb of God, I, a miserable sinner, salute and worship the most Sacred Wound of Your Shoulder on which You did bear Your heavy Cross, which so tore Your flesh and laid bare Your Bones as to inflict on You anguish greater than any other wound of Your Most Blessed Body. I adore You, O Jesus most sorrowful; I praise and glorify You, and give You thanks for this most sacred and painful Wound, beseeching You by that exceeding pain, and by the crushing burden of Your heavy Cross, to be merciful to me, a sinner, to forgive me all my mortal and venial sins, and lead me on towards Heaven along the Way of Your Cross. Amen.






PRAYER BEFORE A CRUCIFIX



In memory of all these pains and sufferings which You did endure before Your Passion on the Cross, grant me before my death true contrition, a sincere and entire confession, worthy satisfaction and the remission of all my sins. Amen.

Heavenly Physician, raised aloft on the Cross to heal our wounds with Yours, remember the bruises which You did suffer and the weakness of all Your Members which were distended to such a degree that never was there pain like Yours. From the crown on Your Head to the Soles of Your Feet there was not one spot on Your Body that was not in torment, and yet, forgetting all Your sufferings, You did not cease to pray to Your Heavenly Father for Your enemies, saying: "Father forgive them, for they know not what they do."

Through this great Mercy, and in memory of this suffering, grant that the remembrance of Your Most Bitter Passion may effect in us a perfect contrition and the remission of all our sins. Amen.

FIFTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Mirror of eternal splendour, remember the sadness which You experienced, when contemplating in the light of Your Divinity the predestination of those who would be saved by the merits of Your Sacred Passion, You did see at the same time, the great multitude of reprobates who would be damned for their sins, and You did complain bitterly of those hopeless, lost, and unfortunate sinners. Through this abyss of compassion and pity, and especially through the goodness which You displayed to the good thief when You said to him: "This day, you shall be with Me in Paradise." I beg of You, O Sweet Jesus, that at the hour of my death, You will show me mercy too. Amen.

SIXTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Beloved and most desirable King, remember the grief You did suffer, when naked and like a common criminal, You were fastened and raised on the Cross, when all Your relatives and friends abandoned You, except Your Beloved Mother, who remained close to You during Your agony and whom You did entrust to Your faithful disciple when You said to Mary: "Woman, behold your son!", and to St. John: "Son, behold your Mother!".

I beg of You, O my Saviour, by the sword of sorrow which pierced the soul of Your holy Mother, to have compassion on me in all my afflictions and tribulations, both corporal and spiritual, and to assist me in all my trials, and especially at the hour of my death. Amen.

SEVENTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Inexhaustible Fountain of compassion, Who by a profound gesture of Love, said from the Cross: "I thirst!" suffered with a thirst for the salvation of the human race: I beg of You, O my Saviour, to inflame in our hearts the desire to tend toward perfection in all our acts, and to extinguish in us the excessive desire of the flesh and the love of worldly things. Amen.

EIGHTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Sweetness of hearts, delight of the spirit, by the bitterness of the vinegar and gall which You did taste on the Cross for Love of us, grant us the grace to receive worthily Your Precious Body and Blood during our life and at the hour of our death, that they may serve as a remedy and consolation for our souls. Amen.

NINTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Royal virtue, joy of the mind, recall the pain You did endure when plunged in an ocean of bitterness at the approach of death, insulted and outraged, You did cry out in a loud voice that You were abandoned by Your Father, saying: "My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?" Through this anguish, I beg of You, O my Saviour, not to abandon me in the terrors and pains of my death. Amen.

TENTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Who art the beginning and end of all things, life and virtue, remember that for our sakes You were plunged in an abyss of suffering from the soles of Your Feet to the crown of Your Head. In consideration of the enormity of Your Wounds, teach me to keep, through pure love, Your Commandments, whose way are wide and easy for those who love You. Amen.

ELEVENTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Deep abyss of mercy, I beg of You, in memory of Your Wounds which penetrated to the very marrow of Your Bones and to the depth of Your being, to draw me, a miserable sinner, overwhelmed by my offences, away from sin and to hide me from Your Face justly irritated against me; hide me in Your Wounds, until Your anger and just indignation shall have passed away. Amen.

TWELFTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Mirror of truth, symbol of unity, link of charity, remember the multitude of wounds with which You were covered from head to foot, torn



and reddened by the spilling of Your adorable Blood. O great and universal pain which You did suffer in Your virginal flesh for love of us! Sweetest Jesus! What is there that You could have done for us that You have not done! May the fruit of Your sufferings be renewed in my soul by the faithful remembrance of Your Passion, and may Your love increase in my heart each day until I see You in eternity.

You, who are the treasury of every real good and every joy, which I beg You to grant me, O sweetest Jesus, in Heaven. Amen.

THIRTEENTH PRAYER (Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Strong lion, immortal and invincible King, remember the pain which You did endure when all Your strength, both moral and physical, was entirely exhausted; You did bow Your Head, saying: "It is consummated." Through this anguish and grief, I beg of You, Lord Jesus, to have mercy on me at the hour of my death when my mind will be greatly troubled and my soul will be in anguish. Amen.

FOURTEENTH PRAYER (Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! Only Son of the Father, splendour and figure of His Substance, remember the simple and humble recommendation You did make of Your Soul to Your Eternal Father, saving: "Father, into Your Hands I commend My spirit!" And with Your Body all torn, and Your Heart broken, and the bowels of Your Mercy open to redeem us, You did expire. By this Precious Death, I beg of You O King of Saints, comfort me and help me to resist the devil, the flesh and the world, so that being dead to the world I may live for You alone. I beg of You at the hour of my death to receive me, a pilgrim and an exile returning to You. Amen.

FIFTEENTH PRAYER

(Our Father, Hail Mary)

O Jesus! True and fruitful Vine! Remember the abundant outpouring of blood which You did so generously shed from Your Sacred Body as juice from grapes in a wine press. From Your Side, pierced with a lance by a soldier, blood

and water issued forth until there was not left in Your Body a single drop, and finally, like a bundle of myrrh lifted to the top of the Cross, Your delicate Flesh was destroyed, the very substance of Your Body withered, and the marrow of Your Bones dried up. Through this bitter Passion, and through the outpouring of Your Precious Blood, I beg of You, O Sweet Jesus, to receive my soul when I am in my death agony. Amen.

CONCLUSION

O Sweet Jesus! Pierce my heart so that my tears of penitence and love will be my bread day and night; may I be converted entirely to You, may my heart be Your perpetual habitation, may my conversation be pleasing to You, and may the end of my life be so praiseworthy that I may merit Heaven and there with Your saints, praise You forever and ever. Amen.

AVE MARIS STELLA

Hail thou star of ocean Portal of the sky Ever Virgin Mother Of the Lord Most High.

O! by Gabriel's Ave, Uttered long ago, Eva's name reversing Established peace below.

Break the captives' fetters, Light on blindness pour, All our ills expelling, Every bliss implore.

Show thyself a Mother, Offer Him our sighs, Who for us incarnate Did not thee despise.

2. THE FLIGHT INTO EGYPT

I compassionate thee, O sorrowful Mother Mary, on account of those distressing fears which thy affectionate heart endured on the flight to Egypt and during thy sojourn there. O dearest Mother, through this thy anxious heart implore for me the virtue of generosity, particularly for the poor, and the Gift of Pietv.

(Hail Mary)

3. THE LOSS OF THE CHILD JESUS IN THE TEMPLE

I compassionate thee, O sorrowful Mother Mary, on account of that anxiety which thy worried heart endured in the loss of thy beloved Child Jesus. O dearest Mother, through this thy exceedingly troubled heart, implore for me the virtue of chastity and the Gift of Knowledge. (Hail Mary)

4. THE MEETING OF JESUS AND MARY ON THE WAY OF THE CROSS

I compassionate thee, O sorrowful Mother Mary, on account of that horror with which thy mother's heart was stricken when meeting Jesus, bearing the Cross. O dearest Mother, through this thy exceedingly oppressed heart, implore for me the virtue of patience and the Gift of Fortitude. (Hail Mary)

5. THE CRUCIFIXION

I compassionate thee, O sorrowful Mother Mary, on account of that martyrdom which tortured thy magnanimous heart at the death-agony of Jesus. O dearest Mother, through this thy martyred heart, implore for me the virtue of temperance and the Gift of Counsel.

(Hail Mary)

6. THE TAKING DOWN OF THE BODY OF IESUS FROM THE CROSS

I compassionate thee, O sorrowful Mother Mary, on account of the anguish inflicted upon thy tender heart by the thrust of the lance that opened the side of Jesus and pierced His Most Adorable Heart. O dearest Mother, through this vicarious transfixion of thy own heart, implore for me the virtue of brotherly love and the Gift of Understanding. (Hail Mary)

7. THE BURIAL OF JESUS

I compassionate thee, O sorrowful Mother Mary, on account of that agony of soul which racked thy most loving heart at the burial of Jesus. O dearest Mother, through this extreme torment that filled thy burdened heart, implore for me the virtue of zeal and the Gift of Wisdom. (Hail Mary)

L. Pray for us, OVirgin Most Sorrowful!

R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

L. Let us pray:

O Lord Jesus Christ, we beseech thee that the most Blessed Virgin Mary, whose soul was pierced by the Sword of Sorrow in the hour of Thy Passion, may be our advocate at the throne of Thy Mercy, now, and at the hour of our death. Through Thee, Jesus Christ, Redeemer of the World, Who livest and reignest with the Father and the Holy Ghost, world without end. Amen.

L. Precious Blood of Christ.

R. Save us!

L. O most beloved and most merciful Infant Jesus of Prague.

R. Save us from moral decline, disasters, plagues and wars forever. Amen.

L. O Mary, most sorrowful, Mother of the faithful.

R. Pray for us.

A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who make the pious exercise of the Way of the Cross; and also go to Confession, receive Holy Communion and recite a prayer for the intentions of the Pope, e.g. one Our Father and one Hail Mary.

In the Way of the Cross we recall anew the sufferings, which the divine Redeemer endured, while going from the praetorium of Pilate, where he was condemned to death, to the mount of Calvary, where he died on the cross for our salvation.

The gaining of the plenary indulgence is regulated by the following norms

- 1) The pious exercise must be made before stations of the Way of the Cross legitimately erected.
- 2) For the erection of the Way of the Cross, fourteen crosses are required, to which it is customary to add fourteen pictures or images, which represent the stations of Jerusalem.
- 3) According to the more common practice, the pious exercise consists of fourteen pious readings, to which some vocal prayers are added. However, nothing more is required than a pious meditation on the Passion and Death of the Lord, which need not be a particular consideration of the individual mysteries of the stations.
- 4) A movement from one station to the next is required. (But if the pious exercise is made publicly and if it is not possible for all taking part to go in an orderly way from station to station, it suffices if at least the one conducting the exercise goes from station to station, the others remaining in their place).

PREPARATORY PRAYER

O most merciful Jesus, with a contrite heart and penitent spirit, I bow down in profound humility before Thy divine majesty. I adore Thee as my supreme Lord and Master; I believe in Thee, I hope in Thee, I love Thee above all things. I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, my Supreme and Only Good. I resolve to amend my life, and although I am unworthy to obtain mercy, yet the sight of Thy holy cross, on which Thou didst die, inspires me with hope and consolation. I will, therefore, meditate on Thy sufferings, and visit the stations of Thy Passion in company with Thy sorrowful Mother and my guardian angel, with the intention of promoting Thy honour and saving my soul.

I desire to gain the indulgences granted for this holy exercise for myself and for the Poor Souls in Purgatory. O merciful Redeemer, who hast said, "And I, if I be lifted from earth, will draw all things to Myself," draw my heart and my love to Thee, that I may perform this devotion as perfectly as possible, and that I may live and die in union with Thee. Amen.

First Station JESUS IS CONDEMNED TO DEATH

L. We adore Thee, O Christ, and we praise Thee

R. Because by Thy holy cross, Thou hast redeemed the world

O Jesus! So meek and uncomplaining, teach me resignation in trials. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

O Jesus, Who for love of me didst bear Thy cross to Calvary, in Thy sweet mercy grant to me to suffer and to die for Thee.



Second Station IESUS CARRIES HIS CROSS

L. We adore Thee, O Christ, and we praise Thee

R. Because by Thy holy cross, Thou hast redeemed the world

My Jesus, this Cross should be mine, not Thine; my sins crucified Thee. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

O Jesus, Who for love of me didst bear Thy cross to Calvary, in Thy sweet mercy grant to me to suffer and to die for Thee.



Third Station JESUS FALLS THE FIRST TIME

L. We adore Thee, O Christ, and we praise Thee

R. Because by Thy holy cross, Thou hast redeemed the world

O Jesus! By this first fall, never let me fall into mortal sin. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)



Fourth Station JESUS MEETS HIS MOTHER

O Jesus! May no human tie, however dear, keep me from following the road of the Cross.

(Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

Fifth Station

SIMON HELPS JESUS CARRY HIS CROSS

L. We adore Thee, O Christ, and we praise Thee

Simon unwillingly assisted Thee; may I with patience suffer all for Thee. (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

VERONICA WIPES THE FACE OF JESUS

Eighth Station

JESUS CONSOLES THE WOMEN OF JERUSALEM

L. We adore Thee, O Christ, and we praise Thee

My greatest consolation would be to hear Thee say: "Many sins are forgiven thee, because thou hast loved much." (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be)

Ninth Station

JESUS FALLS THE THIRD TIME


